Issues fixed in this release

Issue	Description
Cisco ASA – NAT policies missing destination IP	Corrected an issue with ASA migrations where the destination NAT IP was not being added
Cisco ASA - services with same name import	When importing Cisco configurations with same named service objects, differentiated by protocol (TACACS TCP and UDP services in this issue) both are now imported correctly.
Interface TCP-MSS settings not migrating correctly from a PanOS source configuration	Corrected an issue where custom TCP-MSS settings were not being merged correctly
Service override timeout settings not migrating correctly from a PanOS source configuration	Corrected an issue where custom service override timeouts were not being merged correctly
